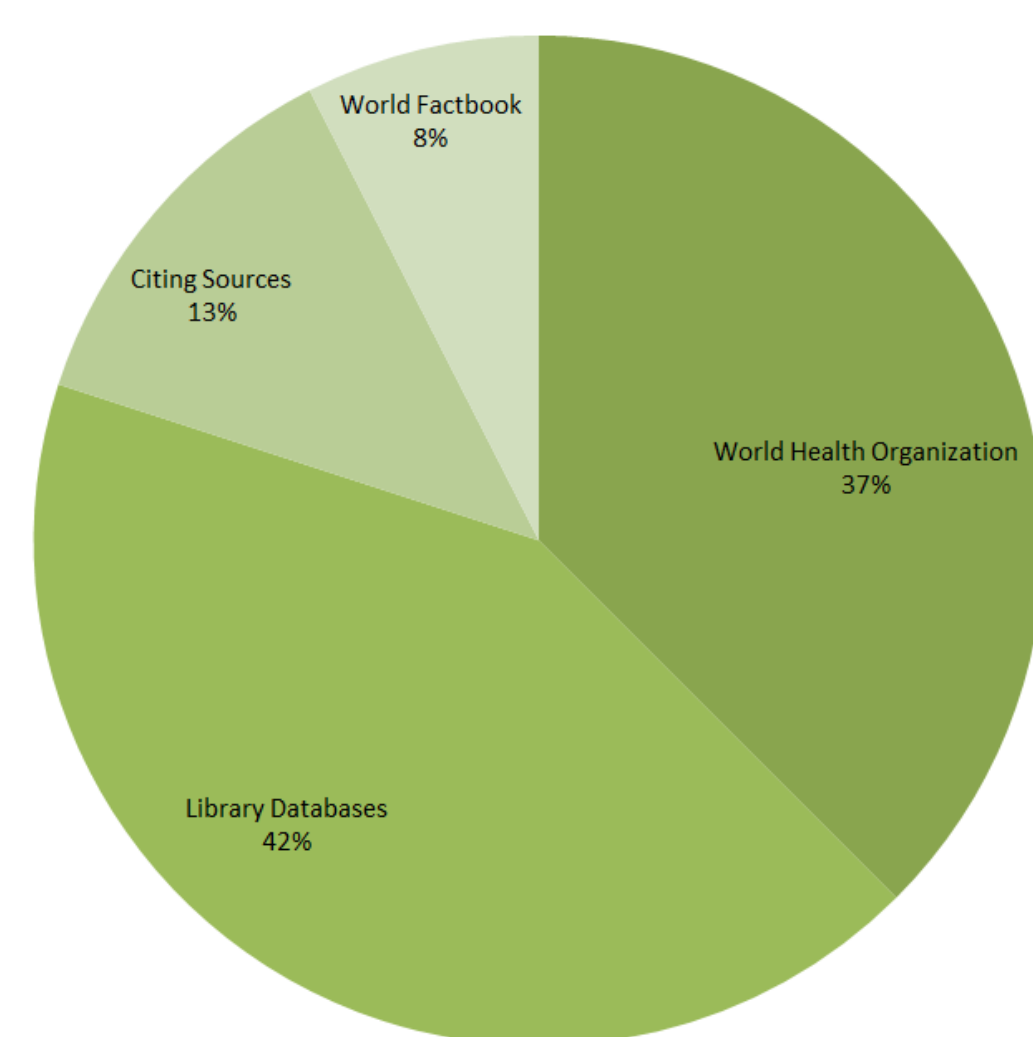


How Cline Library Sustains Researchers' Time

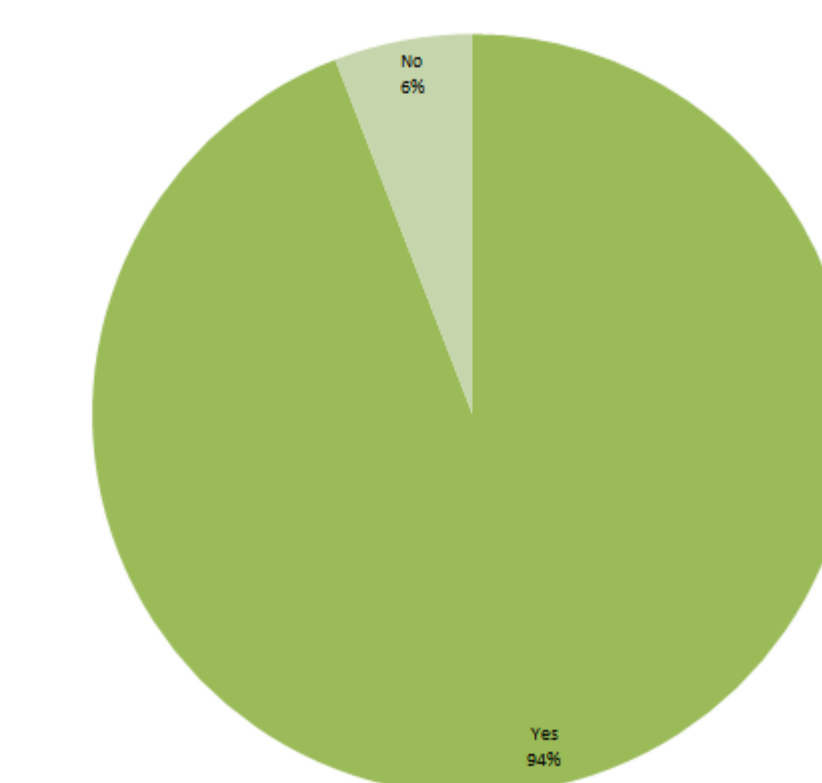
NUR 205 Instruction Session: When students were asked if they'd use research skills they learned in the library session over time, **100% said yes.**

NUR 205: Which two resources from the LibGuide did you find were the most helpful?



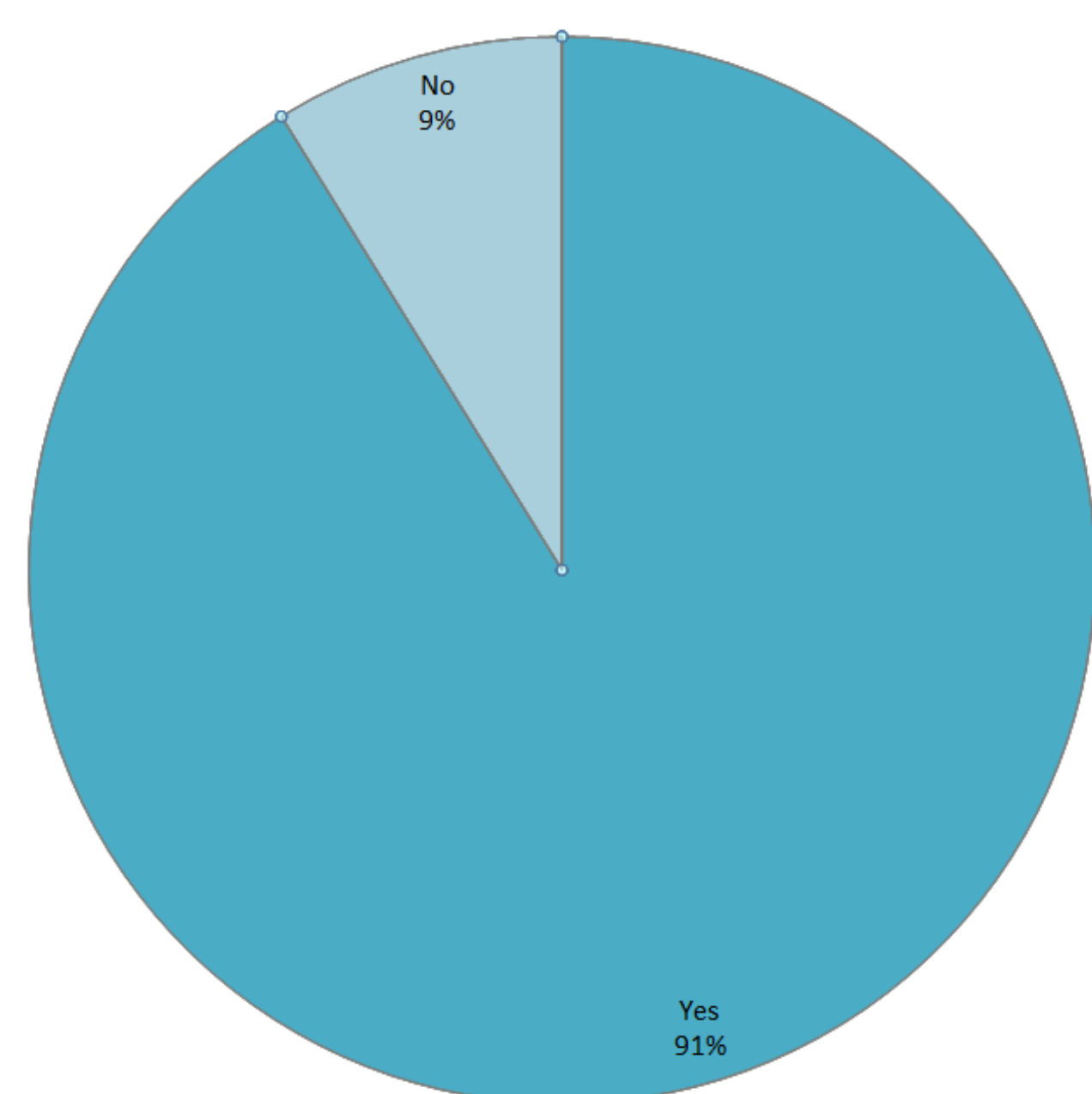

HS 205: Did the LibGuide save you time in finding resources for your assignment?

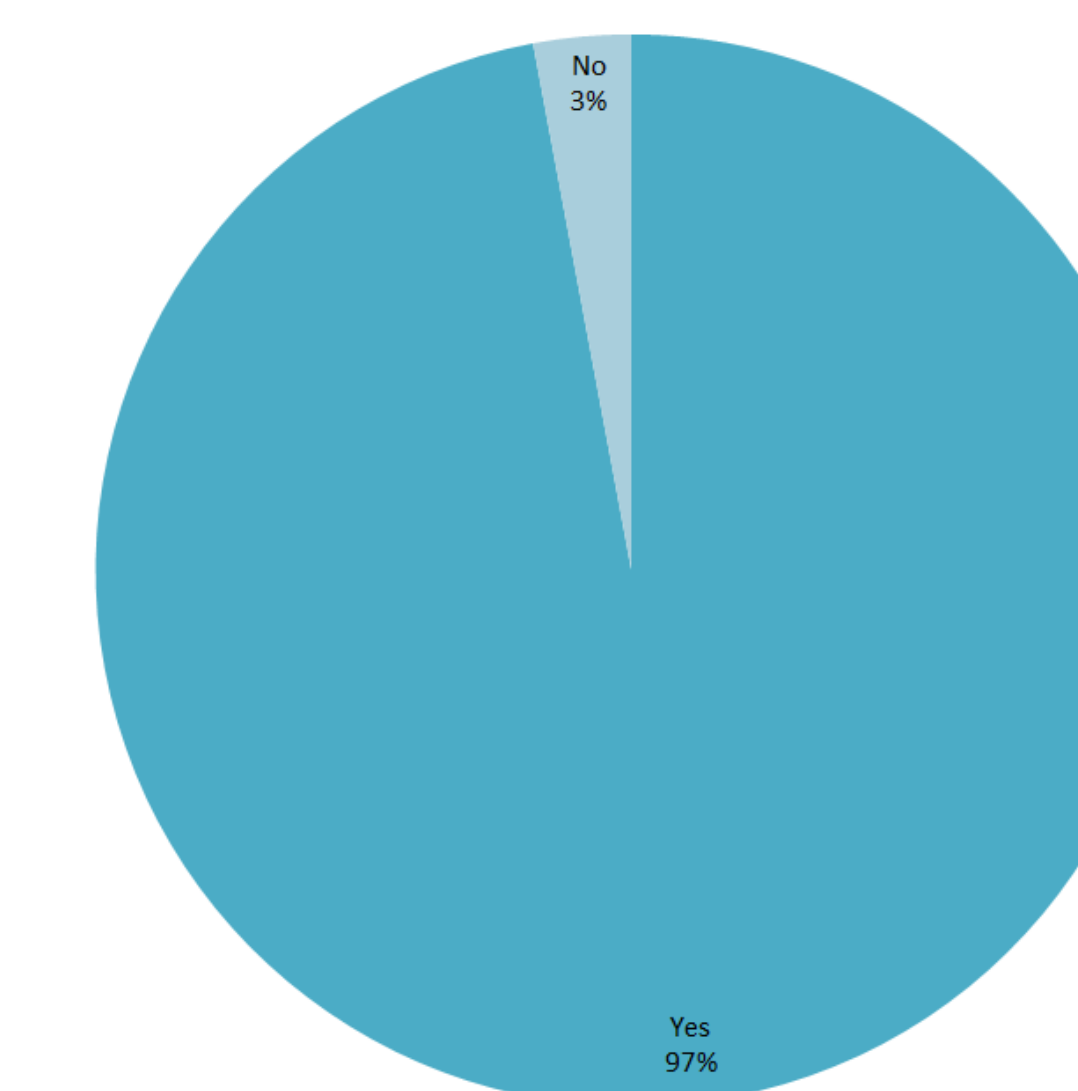


ENG 410C: Research Consultation: "I usually go to Cline Library to help me kick off a project. Usually my research topics are unusual and rather difficult for me to find on my own."
